# Meet Our New Director of Youth Development

# Jim Pottinger

Hello my name is Jim Pottinger and I am a new addition to the Neighborhood Boys & Girls Club family as the Director of Youth Development. My past experience includes working with inner-city youth for over 30 years at the Boys & Girls Clubs of Chicago. I have a proven record of accomplishments working effectively with children and families in low-income environments. I am the recipient of numerous awards showcasing my abilities to effectively work with at-risk youth and teenagers. One of my initiatives was to create a city-wide sports league that involved 16 different locations. In this capacity, I recruited over 1,000 youth to participate in a variety of sports for both boys and girls, as well as facilitated the Organizational Teen Leadership program called the Keystone Club. I am very excited to meet all the alumni, donors and families at the Neighborhood Boys & Girls Club.

# Youth Leadership Program

Youth Leaders are the backbone of our organization, open to youth, teenagers, and young adults ages 13 through 26. Currently, we have over 100 Leaders engaged in the Youth Leadership Program and 21 participating in the Leaders in Training Program (LIT). The Youth Leaders and LITs are responsible for working the counter, helping with the out-of-school time programs, as well as learning to score keep and officiate all sports offered at the NBGC. But most importantly, this Program not only changes their lives, but the lives of their families and friends. This ripple effect makes our community a better place to live.



# Leader Summer Trips

Recently, the Youth Leaders had the opportunity to participate in 3 outdoor education trips that helped them grow in some essential areas, including working together, being responsible and exceeding their goals and expectations. These life lessons are transferable to all aspects of their lives.

<u>Camping and Biking Trip (August 18th & 19th):</u> The Leaders had the opportunity to participate in a 2 day camping and biking trip at the end of the summer. The Leaders worked hard all summer long as day camp counselors and really needed a nice weekend off. What could be better than spending a couple of days in the wilderness camping, swimming and bike riding through the beautiful forest preserves in Wisconsin.

<u>Tubing Trip (August 29th):</u> At the end of the summer day camp program, some fortunate youth at the NBGC had the opportunity to relax and enjoy a beautiful day tubing in Indiana on the Tippecanoe River.

Mississippi Canoe Trip (October 6th - 8th): The Leaders had the opportunity to camp out and canoe for 3 days on the Mississippi River near the town of Savanna, Illinois. They camped on the islands that are part of the Upper Mississippi River Wildlife Refuge in primitive areas without bathrooms or running water. All participants were taught primitive camping skills while adhering to Leave No Trace outdoor guidelines. Paddling can be hard work and tiring, but it was really rewarding for the Leaders to paddle to camp with everything you need to live in the wilderness. They set goals, journaled and talked each day about what they had learned. On the 2nd day, the weather did not permit us to canoe, so we made other plans which was to go and explore a few different historic caves. The Leaders had a great time in the caves, especially when they had to work together to get through some of the tight and slick places. The Leaders really bonded and became good friends during this 3 day excursion.
