In the Chicago Park District Midget Softball Tournament held last week in the Chicago Area, Revere Park, represented by kids of N.B.C., took first place. George Lindley coached the team all the way and did an excellent job in helping them to the championship.

At the start of competition on Monday there were 240 teams in the field and after the final game at Garfield Park on Saturday, Revere was the only unbeaten team. They had to win 7 games in a row to attain this high position. Their victims were Horner Park, Kiwanis, and then a triumph over River Park gave them the Area championship. On Friday they traveled to River Park where they met a tough opponent in Hollywood Park but they won 10 to 9. On Saturday morning they met Dvorak and won 10 to 8, then they mauled Humboldt 20 to 4 to advance to the city finals. With the chips down they beat Bell Park 8 to 3 for the city championship. BASEBALL UNIFORMS

Instead of all the uniforms being given out next week we decided to start right away. The Cadets already received theirs. All teams in T.
